Introductions

Field Day: Still in desperate need of volunteers. Contact people signed up for swimming to see if any are free to come in the morning as well. Time to consider cutting back even more on Field Day activities? Maybe just an afternoon of swimming? Not enough volunteers, and volunteer numbers are dropping every year.

PE Teacher: Applications are being accepted now, tough position to fill at .29 FTE. Ann will email GC once interviews are scheduled to request parent representation on the interview committee. Important to balance the demographics of the committee wherever possible.

We are currently at 124 enrolled for the 2019-20 school year. One accepted K student will not be attending, but we already had 22 enrolled, so this brings us down to the ideal 21. One current 4th grader will be moving away. Because of current numbers, we will only be able to accept 19 k students for 2020-21, but Ann will meet with Dean Gorrell over the summer to discuss this.

#### 2020 Move

- A signage budget is available, but clarification is needed for what this will cover. Teacher nameplates? Office signage? Can we use some towards the mural?
- Greg V. is in charge of district-wide move logistics. He will share information about timelines, labeling, etc. He is not available in the summer, so this info won't be available before fall.
- What can GC do to support the move and minimize the impact on students and teachers during the school year?
- PE Equipment: We did not get the grant, still looking at shareable "units" across the district. We won't know how much funding is needed until we know what we can get from other school's surplus or shared materials.

### **Budget Discussion:**

- No change to FTE for 2019-20
- Changes are being made by District/DPI to account numbers, lots of shifting, no great impact, just FYI
- Operating budget stays small, supplemented by fundraising dollars, to allow us to maintain guidance and resource teacher supports.
- Tech budget- Should a portion be allotted to teachers? Wait until end of year in case of needed repairs/replacements, then divide remainder between teachers for apps, gear, etc.
- Line item for professional development for teachers?
- Maintain \$500 discretionary funds for each classroom teacher
- A bigger discussion is needed, ideally involving Tammy and Brett.
- Budget meeting set for July 16 at 6pm, location TBD

### VAIS Cooperation for shared items:

• Rikki emailed, has not heard back, VAIS has large fundraiser tonight, will likely reply when that dust settles.

• Will need to coordinate on Book Room, Library, PE, Mural

## Hydroponics

- Opportunity to have hydroponic food production equipment from Fork Farms. \$3500 if paid by end of June. We do not have \$3500 for this, but are very interested.
- District nutrition person is interested in working with us on this
- Looking into other funding sources.
- Would be housed in Konop classroom for now, with potential for expansion into larger room near cafeteria at K-Wing.

- Do we want to drop any fundraisers?
- What do we need to raise next year, for regular budget items AND move related needs? Library is at 3,000 books, goal is 5,000, Mural? PE equipment? Teachers' additional needs for new rooms?

  - o Balance teacher spending autonomy with parents' desire for targeted giving
- Offer "opt out of fundraising" fee as an option?
- Auction reaches beyond NCS community
  - Look at more events to branch out to givers outside of NCS families: Pancake breakfast,
     Bingo, Food Carts...
